Animal Welfare Academy	<p><u>Beach Clean Ups and Marine Biodiversity Educational Talks</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conduct beach clean-ups and marine biodiversity educational talks with preschoolers. • Set up collection points in preschools and engage children to collect plastic recyclables.

Ariessa Koh Hwi-Eun	<p><u>Sustainable Living Workshops and Roadshows</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engage communities through interactive talks to empower individuals to make conscious consumer choices and adopt sustainable lifestyles. • Enable participants to create their own eco-friendly alternatives to conventional products like soap and recycled paper and plastics through workshops.

Engage residents through workshops on food waste reduction and smaller scale planting structures.

Pro Bono SG	<p><u>Green Justice!</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conduct a series of guided nature tours at Woodlands Botanical Garden intertwining nature appreciation with legal education for the public and youths. Mobilise partners and volunteers to produce content on environmental law for guided tours and marketing collaterals, as well as facilitate the tours.
268.	Singapore Environment Council	<p><u>Secret Seashores</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conduct experiential trails, workshops, and activities for schools and students, focusing on mangrove habitats. Conduct workshops involving mangrove clean-ups and the upcycling of plastics.

Srushti Santosh Kamat	<p><u>Using Social Virtual Reality (VR) to Enhance Attitudes Towards Plastic Waste Pollution</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conduct a day-long event featuring a VR project called 'Drop in the Ocean,' to educate on the harmful impact of ocean microplastics on marine biology. Engage participants on a conversation about their experiences with plastic pollution.
