Petersberg Climate Dialogue 2023

From 1 to 3 May, Senior Minister of State (SMS) for Sustainability and the Environment Dr Koh Poh Koon attended the Petersberg Climate Dialogue (PCD) 2023 in Berlin, Germany. The discussions focused on concrete policy actions and tools that countries may take to achieve low carbon and climate resilience. During the dialogue, Singapore also co-facilitated a workshop on decarbonisation and just transition with Denmark.

In addition, SMS Koh met Saudi Arabia Minister of Energy Prince Abdulaziz bin Salman Al Saud, Saudi Arabia Minister of State for Foreign Affairs and Envoy for Climate Affairs Adel Al Jubeir, Pakistan Minister for Climate Change Sherry Rehman, and other stakeholders. They discussed potential bilateral cooperation opportunities in areas including enhancing cities resiliency and raising ambition through Article 6-aligned carbon markets collaborations.

Singapore-Nanjing Special Projects Cooperation Panel

On 16 May, SMS Koh co-chaired the Singapore-Nanjing Special Projects Cooperation Panel (SNCP) with Nanjing Mayor Chen Zhichang.

The 10th SNCP is an important milestone in Singapore-Nanjing cooperation. SMS Koh and Mayor Chen reaffirmed the close ties between Singapore and Nanjing, underpinned by the anchor project Singapore-Nanjing Eco Hi-Tech Island (SNEHTI).

SMS Koh and Mayor Chen signed the SNCP 4th renewal Memorandum of Understanding for collaboration in various areas, including new areas in green development and modern services.

In his keynote speech at the 2023 Sino-Singapore Green Sustainability Forum held in conjunction with SNCP meeting, SMS Koh noted that SNEHTI would be suitable for Singapore companies to test and demonstrate sustainability-related solutions.
