At the event, she spoke on the need for a multi-stakeholder approach to spur effective climate action, and on the Singapore Green Plan 2030. In a panel discussion with Andreas Brandstetter, President of Insurance Europe, and Nina dos Santos, Europe Editor, CNN International, she discussed the growing role of investors in the green transition.

She met with the Nationale-Nederlanden (NN) Investment Partners and exchanged ideas on climate finance and Environmental Social Governance reporting.

Singapore and Indonesia recently signed several landmark MOUs on Sustainability and Climate Change as well as on Green and Circular Economy Development. Awang Haji Suhaimi bin Haji Gafar, Minister of Primary Resources and Tourism Dato Seri Setia Awang Haji Ali Bin Apong, Deputy Minister of Finance and Economy (Economy) Dato Seri Paduka Dr Haji Abdul Manaf bin Haji Metussin, Deputy Minister of Development Dato Seri Paduka Ar. Awang Haji Mazruke bin Haji Mohsin, and Permanent Secretary of Land Use and Environment Dr Nor Imtihan binti Haji Abdul Razak.

MOS and the Ministers took stock of bilateral and regional environment cooperation under the long-standing MOU between Brunei's Ministry of Development and Singapore's Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment. As small countries, Singapore and Brunei are both vulnerable to the impacts of climate change and can learn from each other's approaches to overcome these challenges.
